


STUDENTS' SATISFACTION SURVEY BRIEF REPORT (2021-2022)


CURRICULAR ASPECTS


PROFESSIONAL KNOWLEDGE, PRACTICE AND ENGAGEMENT OF TEACHERS

Conceptualization, creative and analytical thinking of the faculty has been rated as excellent nearly 47% of students. Most of the students, nearly 48.9% of students are very fortunate with effective doubt clarification and availability of the teachers for unveiling the doubt even outside of the classroom. The initiation, ignition and encouragement of Interaction is rated by the 55.3% of students as excellent.



LIBRARY RESOURCES AND INFRASTRUCTURE




